If you need help finding a lawyer, we suggest asking family and friends for recommendations or checking the Law Society of Ontario for a list of qualified lawyers.

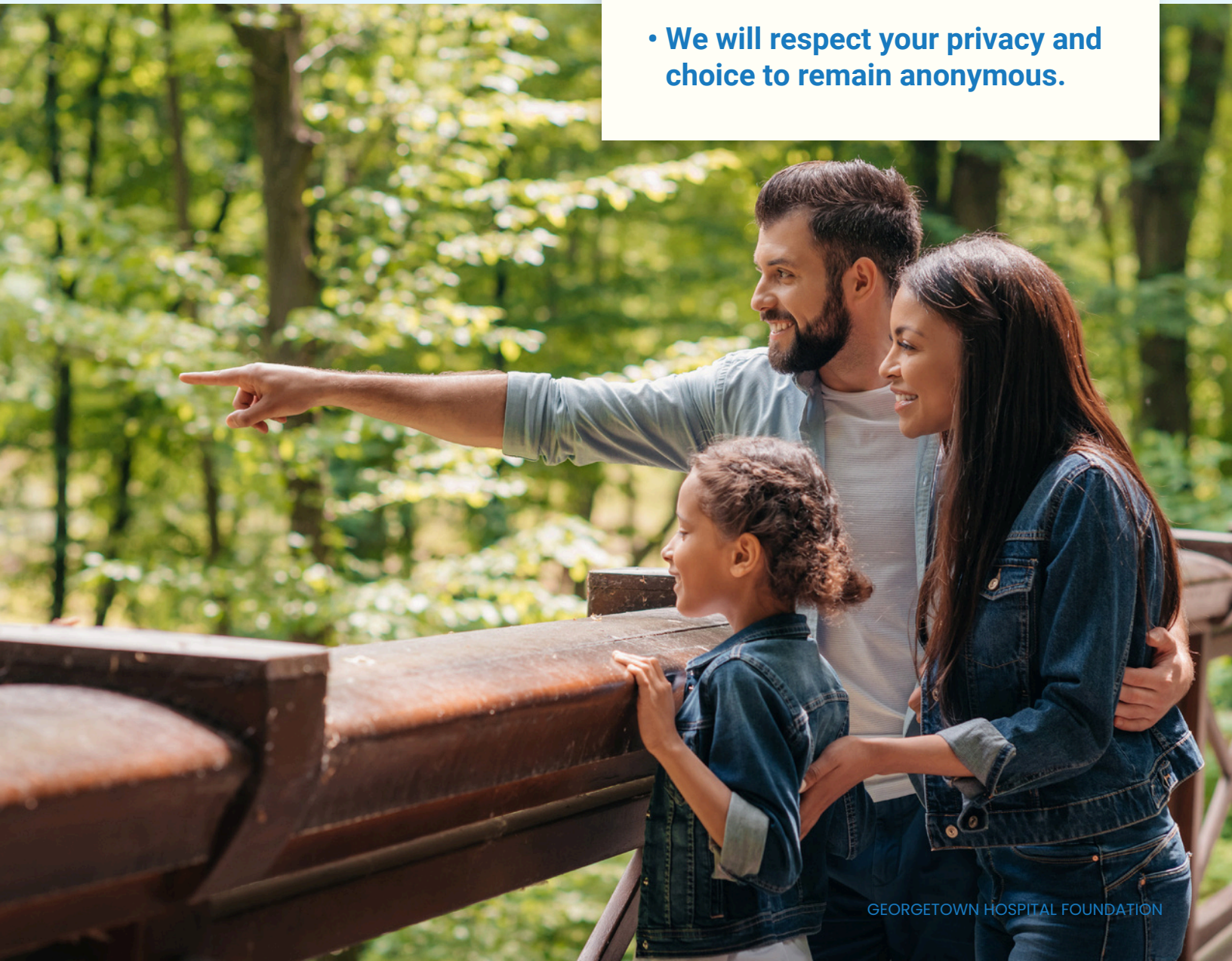
“I may change my mind”
